



INTRODUCING THE BOOK FAIR eWALLET



No cash on hand the day of the Book Fair? Worried about your child carrying cash, misplacing their money or losing a check? No worries – you can now enjoy a new digital payment option called eWallet. It is safe, secure and cash free. Better yet, it only takes a few minutes to set up.

WHAT?

eWallet is a new, secure, cash-free digital payment option that can be used to shop the in-school Book Fair.

WHO?

Parents create an account online for their student. Parents also set a spending limit. Your child will not spend more than the amount you set.

WHERE? eWallets are used to shop the *in-school* Book Fair, not the online Book Fair.

WHEN? eWallets can be set up *as early as two weeks prior to and through the last day of the in-school Book Fair*. Students can shop with their eWallets *any day* of the Book Fair.

HOW?

To set up your child's online eWallet account, visit:

On the page, you will find a section titled "Go Cash Free". Simply click on "Get Started" and follow the prompts. You will need a credit card. Once the account is set up, the funds are immediately available for your child to shop the Book Fair.

WHAT ABOUT THE UNSPENT MONEY?

A credit card is used to open your child's account. Scholastic will apply a hold on your credit card for the amount of your choice. Once the in-school Book Fair is over, the hold on your credit card for the unused funds will be lifted.

DO I NEED TO BE PRESENT WHEN MY CHILD USES eWALLET?

No. In fact, eWallet is perfect for parents who are unable to attend the Book Fair. The account you set up online with Scholastic will be linked to your child's name, grade level and teacher's name. Our register will have access to the list of students who have opted to shop with eWallet. Your child simply has to let us know his/her name, grade level and teacher's name. We will immediately be able to determine how much money your child is allowed to spend.
