



PAINT THE OTTER ROCKS!



For a reservation of \$30, congratulate your favorite student, wish them a happy birthday (or "half" birthday), show appreciation to your favorite teacher or staff member, or just let everyone know how much you love Ocean Palms Elementary School! ***Exciting news for this year – you are now allowed to use spray paint which will make the process that much faster and even more fun!***

HOW DO I SIGN UP?

All reservations are made online via SignUp Genius link. *Please select carefully as we have two rocks available - one at the Bus Loop and one at the Car Loop.* Some school dates are not listed as the rocks will be decorated for school events. Payment can be made through SignUp Genius or by sending in a check to Ocean Palms Elementary PTO. Please keep in mind that your date is not confirmed unless we have received your payment.

Reservations are processed on a first come, first served basis. The earlier you make your reservation, the more likely you are to secure your desired date(s). Additionally, remember that there are approximately 180 school days per year, and that OPE has over 470 students registered. Please understand if the date you requested is unavailable.

HOW MANY TIMES CAN I SIGN UP?

Any individual, team, or event may be the subject of an Otter Rock for a limit of three days (in succession or not in succession) per calendar month. Anyone not abiding by this rule will have their reservation cancelled and their payment refunded (less the SignUp Genius fees).

HOW SOON CAN I PAINT THE ROCKS?

You may start painting your designated rock at 3:30 p.m. on the day before your reserved date(s). For example, if you reserved the rock for a Tuesday, you may start painting at 3:30 p.m. on Monday. You will need to paint the rock between 3:30 p.m. and 6 p.m. the day prior to your reservation. Rocks reserved for Monday should be painted the prior Friday between 3:30 p.m. and 6 p.m.

ARE THERE ANY RESTRICTIONS ON DECORATIONS?

What is painted on an Otter Rock MUST be in good taste and MAY NOT contain any foul language, discriminatory, religious, and/or political statements/symbols. Profanity and obscenities are not permitted. You may only promote a business if they are a Corporate Partner with OPE.

Character Counts here in St. Johns County. All messages should be affirming! Designs should have a caring and nurturing message. All wording and symbols must be positive.

The rocks run on the honor system, with the hope that everyone will respect these guidelines.

WHAT SUPPLIES DO I NEED TO PAINT THE ROCK?

Woo hoo! This year you are allowed to use spray paint! We are not allowed to store spray paint on school property, so you will need to supply your own.

If you still would like to use paint, please use the Rustoleum brand and be sure to bring paint brushes. Painting tip: Bring a piece of chalk to write any letters/words before painting! An Otter Rock Borrow Bin is located in the front office with a selection of Rustoleum paint. Help yourself to what's in the bin or feel free to donate any leftover paint you may have for the next person.

Families, groups or organizations must furnish their own labor, paint and supplies to paint a rock. Any paintbrushes used must be washed at home.

ONLY the rock can be painted. Painting on sidewalks, lampposts or buildings is prohibited. Any damage or destruction to the surrounding areas or buildings will deem the family, group or organization financially responsible for cleaning and repair costs. This means that ALL PAINT SUPPLIES MUST STAY NEAR THE OTTER ROCKS. We recommend using plastic drop cloths to protect the mulch, stones, driveway and curb while you are painting.

Bring a large trash bag to take home all items/supplies after the painting is complete. You will not have access to water on site to rinse off brushes. You will need to properly discard all painting supplies at home and not on school grounds. Used paint cans are not to be placed in campus trash bins or dumpsters. Please dispose of paint cans properly off campus.

WHAT IF IT'S RAINING WHEN IT'S TIME FOR ME TO PAINT?

There will be no refunds, even due to the weather. Unfortunately you may have to hold an umbrella if it is raining. If you are unable to paint the rock on schedule according to your reservation (due to a conflict in your schedule, forgetfulness, weather, etc.), please contact Stephanie Marciani (shmorse@yahoo.com) to see about switching to a new date.
