Children's Access to Art Program

As a CAAP Volunteer, you will bring reproductions of famous art masterpieces from our extensive collection into the classroom for discussion. Each reproduction is accompanied by a guide containing information on the artist, the painting, and stimulating questions for the students to consider.

We'll train you for CAAP in a one-hour orientation in September.

You then coordinate with the teacher (and other volunteers if there are more than one per class) monthly visits that work with your schedule. Visits can be as short as 20 minutes with a maximum of one hour—depending on what you and the teacher decide. Corresponding art projects can be used to supplement the lesson, but are optional.
